***** Command Pad is a free application for managing your command line programs and scripts. From a single icon you can add new command line tasks, start, stop and pause them. Each task has a title, command, working directory, URL and optionally a command line alias. You can save your list of tasks into config files and view them with a single click. Command Pad provides additional capabilities like a running list of all tasks, detailed task overview, current status of your tasks, changes to tasks and notifications when tasks end or are paused. Simply give it a try and start managing your command line tasks in an instant! CLI Commands: ***** Command Pad supports various command line applications such as git, wget, curl, Git, Java, HTML and more. Command line tasks can be quickly added or edited by using the quick entry or full path. Tasks can be stopped using mouse clicks. Command line aliases can be defined for tasks. Aliases are used to replace task names by short text and are added by placing your alias text in the alias box. Command line task name, working directory, URL and command line alias can be configured for each task. Keyboard Shortcuts: ***** Command Pad provides keyboard shortcuts for each command line task to speed up the process. You can activate them by entering the corresponding keystroke when hovering over a task. Viewing Tasks: ***** Command Pad can display a compact list of all tasks, a detailed task overview and even update status of tasks if you have configured it to do so.
